RIDGELAND

The basis of the City of Ridgeland logo is the geological ridge where the area was first settled. Originally called Highland Colony, Ridgeland was founded on one of the highest ridges in central Mississippi and the site of the highest elevation on the Illinois Central railroad. Ridgeland was incorporated in 1899, named after this long ridge of rich soil that brought economic prosperity.

The ridge and its contour lines take on the appearance of an “r” when the logo is turned on its side. The logo’s contemporary design of a historically significant feature serves to link Ridgeland’s past and future. Thus, the City of Ridgeland logo represents not only the ridge upon which the City is named, but also the innovative approach to its future.
