

Ridgeland Curbside Recycling

Please set out all recyclables by 7:00 a.m. on your designated collection day.

The items listed below can be recycled and placed in your bin. Do not place household garbage or non-recyclable items in the bin.

Beverage Cartons and Boxes

Milk and juice cartons and juice boxes clean and drained.

Glass Bottles and Jars

Drain all bottles before recycling and place the bottle caps in the garbage. Light bulbs, mirror, ceramic and pyrex glass are not accepted.

Food and Beverage Containers

Aluminum food and beverage cans (do not flatten) and aluminum foil trays and pie plates. Containers must be rinsed out and clean.

Polystyrene Foam Packaging

Foam egg cartons, protective packaging and take-out food containers. Food and food residue must be rinsed from take-out food containers.

Plastic Bottles, Jugs and Jars

Drain all bottles before recycling and place the bottle caps in the garbage.

Plastic Tubs and Lids

Plastic food tubs such as for yogurt, margarine, sour cream, cottage cheese and ice cream. All food tubs and lids must be clean. Separate lids before placing in recycling box.

Printed Paper

Dry newspapers, catalogues, magazines, telephone and paperback books, junk mail, and envelopes

Boxboard Cartons

Food boxes such as cereal, cookie and frozen food with the liners removed and thrown away. Tissue boxes, shoe boxes, egg cartons, and detergent boxes that are clean, empty and flattened. Soiled paper products are not recyclable and must be thrown away.

Flattened Cardboard Boxes

Small cardboard must be flattened and placed within the recycling bin. Flatten large cardboard and place within another cardboard box or place it securely underneath or between your recycling bin.
