

# What is CEDA?

(Citizens for Economic Development Act)

- ◉ Simply enabling legislation, not a tax itself
- ◉ Financially wise
- ◉ Economic development tool
- ◉ CEDA revenues provide for new projects and jobs



# CEDA Summary

- Available to all municipalities
- Requires a 60% referendum approval by voters
- Revenue stays in community
- Funds can only be used for specific capital/infrastructure projects identified on ballot

# CEDA Summary

- Municipal residents can vote in a municipal election for an optional sales tax of up to 1% to be collected from businesses inside the municipal limits
- A CEDA levy is NEVER permanent
- Includes provisions to exempt businesses already collecting a tourism tax

# CEDA Means Options

- CEDA means giving citizens a vote on the future of their community



- CEDA means having the opportunity to do more for the people of Mississippi

# The Bottom Line

- CEDA is an option, not a mandate
- CEDA reflects the will of the people
- Mississippi communities have great needs



# The Bottom Line

- Local governments need options to meet these needs
- 32 other states currently use some form of a local option sales tax effectively
- Allows real dollars savings on interest payments and gets projects paid for faster
