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City of Ridgeland to celebrate Mississippi's Healthiest Hometown Award with free 5K and 1-mile fun run

(Ridgeland, Mississippi – Sept. 13, 2013) – City of Ridgeland officials have announced plans for a Healthiest Hometown Celebration in recognition of its award, Mississippi's Healthiest Hometown 2013 by the Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Mississippi Foundation. The city will accept a \$50,000 grant from the Foundation at the event set for Saturday, Oct. 19. A free 5K and a 1-mile fun run will use the Ridgeland Multiuse Trail, leaving from Olde Towne Ridgeland Plaza at 8 a.m. T-shirts will be given to the first 200 pre-registered participants.

"When we accepted the award at the 2013 Mississippi Municipal League Annual Conference, we knew that we wanted to celebrate in a healthy way that involved the community," said Gene McGee, Mayor. "Ridgeland earned the award due to significant efforts by our city government working with Ridgeland schools, churches, businesses and organizations. The efforts of the Healthy Hometown Committee which represents all facets of the community helped make this award possible."

The event schedule includes check-in/registration at 7:15 a.m. followed by a warm-up led by personal fitness trainer, Lisa Newman. Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Mississippi Foundation will present the award check to the City of Ridgeland prior to the run/walk. The 5K will begin at 8 a.m. The 1-mile fun run will begin at 8:05 a.m.

The \$50,000 grant award will be used to support ongoing health initiatives in Ridgeland. Plans to use the grant money will be announced at the event.
