



VOTING INFORMATION

U.S. citizens may register to vote at Ridgeland City Hall for municipal, county, state and federal elections.

Municipal elections for the City of Ridgeland include the offices of Mayor and a seven-member Board of Aldermen. Each of the city's six wards has one Alderman and there is one Alderman-at-large. Elections occur every four years. The next election will be held in 2017.
